Herein is the written agreement made between Master Milton Robin Beasley of Strawberry Cottage, Dulverton, Somerset and Raymond Arthur Northmoor, 12th Baron Exmoor, signed and witnessed in the presence of Mr James Harman, Attorney-at-law.

I, Milton Robin Beasley, do admit to having had relations with Rt Hon. Gloria Northmoor.

I, Milton Robin Beasley, hereby undertake to break off all subsequent contact with Rt Hon. Gloria Northmoor on the understanding that the relationship, being detrimental to the social standing of Miss Northmoor, is not in her best interests. Furthermore I agree to never see her, write to her or contact her by any means ever again, barring one last letter to be dictated by the other parties in this agreement.

In recompense, I, Raymond Arthur Northmoor, will provide Milton Robin Beasley with the sum of £200 a year until the 4th July 1950 to be paid into a bank account of his choice. I will also waive all rents payable to the Northmoor estate by the inhabitants of Strawberry Cottage for the same period of time.
