"In a country house near Dulverton there walks the Green Lady. Unusually, this figure of a woman is not the commonly reported white apparition of other sites, or the archetypal grieving veiled figure dressed all in black, but instead wears an old fashioned green dress.

She has been seen in several locations in the house and gardens, rather than in the more usual single area. She has manifested both as a stationary figure and also walking in certain areas.

Those who have seen her claim to have heard bells."

"My grandmother was sent to be in service in a country house on the moors. She was there only one month in winter when she came home to her parents and would not speak a word of what had happened.
